# The University of Jordan Library, UJL

The University of Jordan Library provides its services to the users of the university family, students and researchers since the establishment of the university in 1962; an area of about (12696.66 m<sup>2</sup>), in addition to (13) reading halls distributed to all faculties and centers of the University, this organizational structure of the library consists of (3) Departments and (9) divisions provide services to the university family of faculty and administrative staff, students and researchers who subscribe in library services from all institutions and members of the community and the international community using the latest technical, technological and administrative techniques, The daily number of visitors and students who get benefit from these services is (11000). the number of visitors to the library's website about (1,126,247) thousand visitors during the year 2018/2019. The paper and electronic holdings amount to about (1.326.252) million library materials, and the library continues to enrich its scientific and literary materials continuously to meet the academic and research needs of its visitors from information sources, and distinguished library materials and services as it hosts many of the depository centers, including the Theses Deposit Center as the library is considered the depository center for theses and dissertations that granted by the member universities in the Association of Arab Universities, the Center includes (85.031) theses. Also the Library is a center of the United Nations publications since 1970. It includes the World Bank publications since 1999 and the IMF bulletins since 2001, and includes an archive of Arabic manuscripts, documents, records and newspapers, and seeks to increase the digital and electronic holdings of books, magazines and theses by subscribing to international and Arab databases in various scientific disciplines has reached the number of digital holdings of nearly (445000) thousand Information items. This is in addition to archiving about 98.08% of the Arab university theses and making them available to researchers inside the library, which is reflected positively in raising the classification of the university ranking, and the conversion of materials for the visually impaired students to audio material by recording them in the studio in the laboratory for the visually impaired

students. The library provides the necessary training that will encourage publication in highly ranked journals and promote the use of information resources in the digital environment. In pursuit of the University's strategic goal of becoming a Smart University, the Library launched the Smartphone application for the library system and the inauguration of the BLS integrated learning station within the METHODS project, which is supported by Erasmus. The Library continues to work on the development of technical infrastructure and attention to digitalization projects. The mobile phone application project has been started, in addition to the development of library and digital library holdings in quantity, and providing all necessary resources of information and knowledge in all its forms that contribute in the process of learning, teaching and development of scientific research.


